## Clinics run Thursday evenings from 6:30 – 7:30pm!

Cost is \$30 per clinic, with a discount to \$20 per clinic if you pre-pay for 3 or more!

**Dogs must be friendly with people and able to work near other dogs in order to participate in clinics.**

If your dog hasn't participated in a group class at Go Play!, we may require an evaluation prior to the start of the clinic to ensure your dog will be comfortable training at our facility. Vaccinations will be verified, all dogs must be current on distemper / parvo vaccines and dogs over 6 months must have a current rabies vaccine. We need a minimum of three students enrolled for each clinic to run.

**May 16<sup>th</sup>: Introduction to Rally-Obedience** Rally-O is a fun and interactive sport for both dog and handler - a course of obedience and obstacles is completed. Rally-O focuses on creating teamwork between the dog and handler. It is fun and enjoyable for dogs in all levels of training!

**May 23<sup>rd</sup>: Introduction to Nose Work / Scent Work** All dogs enjoy sniffing everything possible, but some dogs truly seem to have an outstanding nose. Learn how to read your dog's body language when they are on the trail of something interesting!

**May 30<sup>th</sup>: Recall (Come When Called)** Does your dog come when called? Are you tired of having your dog ignore your recall when off-leash? This clinic is for YOU! Learn tricks and tips to make your dog's recall stronger!

**June 6<sup>th</sup>: Outdoor Adventure** (weather permitting) Take training to the next level! Held completely outside, this clinic will work on training your dog to behave outdoors! We work on teaching your dog to come to you when called, basic manners, and proper outdoor etiquette. This class is ideal if you are having trouble getting their dog to focus on you when outdoors! Because this class is held outdoors, it will be held weather permitting.

**June 13<sup>th</sup>: Trick Training** Have you always wanted to teach your dog amazing and cute tricks to show off to your friends and family? Are you interested in teaching your dog to help around the house and pick up his toys, turn lights on and off, and fetch things? This class is for you! We will teach you tricks and work on helpful tasks.

**June 20<sup>th</sup>: Pet First Aid** Do you know what to do in case of an emergency? Come to our Pet First Aid Seminar to find out! Learn the basics - normal pet vital signs, etc. Please leave your own dog at home - we will have demo dogs here for you to practice hands-on first aid technique treatments! This class is taught by experienced pet care professionals who are certified in Pet First Aid & CPR by the American Red Cross.

**June 27<sup>th</sup>: Intro to Pet Grooming** Do you know how to properly care for your dog's coat? Let us show you the tools needed to keep your dog in tip-top shape and the proper techniques to brush them comfortably. We will also show you how to clear your dog's ears, clip nails, and brush teeth.
