MONDAY NIGHT CLASSES – Start date: 6 / 5 / 17

PUPPY S.T.A.R. KINDERGARTEN: 6:15 – 7:15pm, 6 weeks for \$180.00 A basic puppy obedience class for all puppies 8 weeks through 6 months old. We focus on problem solving all puppy behaviors such as play biting, chewing, digging, jumping, and barking. We also help with crate training, housebreaking, and socialization. Basic commands covered such as sit, down, stand, wait, off, come, stay, leave it, and leash walking. This class follows the AKC Star Puppy Program criteria and is taught by an AKC approved Evaluator.

INTRO TO AGILITY: 7:30 – 8:00pm, 3 weeks for \$75.00 Designed to introduce dogs to the sport of agility – beginner obstacles including teeter, weaves, jumps, a-frame, dog walk, as well as handling skills are taught! This class is for dogs of all ages.

TUESDAY NIGHT CLASSES – Start date: 6 / 13 / 17

CANINE GOOD CITIZEN / THERAPY DOG PREP: 6:15 – 6:45pm, 4 weeks for \$80.00 An advanced obedience class for a dog preparing to begin training for Therapy work. Dogs must already know how to sit, lie down, and stay on command as well as be friendly toward other dogs and humans. The AKC CGC test will be given the last week of class.

ADULT BEGINNER 30/30: 7:00 – 8:00pm, 3 weeks for \$150.00 For dogs 6 months and older. A basic beginner class for the more active dog. Basic commands covered such as sit, down, stand, wait, off, come, stay, leave it, and leash walking. 30 minutes beginner obedience and 30 minutes beginner agility instruction are taught each week.

WEDNESDAY NIGHT CLASSES – Start date: 5 / 24 / 17

BEGINNER I OBEDIENCE: 6:15 – 6:45pm, 6 weeks for \$90.00 A basic beginner obedience class for dogs 6 months and older. Commands covered such as sit, down, stand, wait, off, come, stay, leave it, and leash walking.

BEGINNER II OBEDIENCE: 7:00 – 7:30pm, 6 weeks for \$90.00 30 minutes of intermediate / advanced obedience each week, dogs worked on and off-leash. Dogs must have already completed Puppy Kindergarten, Beginner I, or Beginner 30/30.

THURSDAY NIGHT CLASSES – Start date: 5 / 25 / 17

INTRO TO AGILITY: 6:15 – 6:45pm, 3 weeks for \$75.00 Designed to introduce dogs to the sport of agility – beginner obstacles including teeter, weaves, jumps, a-frame, dog walk, as well as handling skills are taught! This class is for dogs of all ages.

AGILITY I: 7:00 – 8:00pm, 3 weeks for \$150.00 Dogs must have already taken Beginner 30 / 30 or Intro to Agility. Intermediate Agility obstacles, coursework, and handling skills taught. This class is mostly off-leash coursework.

We offer positive reinforcement training in a relaxed setting. A small student-to-teacher ratio provides plenty of individual attention!
